2025 Concours Entry Form

Rules Governing the Entry of Motor Cars in the Rolls-Royce Owners' Club Australia (New South Wales Branch) Inc – operating as the Rolls-Royce & Bentley Car Club of NSW

The following rules are provided for the guidance of members entering their cars for judging in the NSW Club Concours. The full context of the rules governing the entry into and the conduct of the NSW Club Concours are contained in the Federal Judging Manual and will take precedence where any conflict occurs.

Right of Entry for Concours - Only eligible motor cars that have specifically entered for the Concours, in accordance with the time limits placed thereon by the Chief Judge, will be judged. Only eligible motor cars that have been specifically entered for the "Age & Authenticity Trophy" or for the "Best Restoration" Trophy by completing the appropriate Entry Form for these two trophies shall be judged for these trophies. Any late entries will be at the discretion of the Chief Judge. Only cars that are driven under their own power in the traditional cavalcade from the published gathering point to the NSW Club Concours venue will be eligible to be judged.

Eligible Motor Car - This is defined in the Deed Constituting the Rolls-Royce Owners' Club of Australia, paragraph 1.1, as being "Any motor car built by Royce Limited, Rolls-Royce Distributing Limited, Rolls-Royce Limited, Bentley Motor Cars (1931) Limited, Rolls-Royce of America Inc., Rolls-Royce Motors Limited, Rolls-Royce Motor Cars Limited, Bentley Motors Limited or their successors". Bentley cars fitted with Rolls-Royce radiator shells (or vice versa) are to remain as eligible cars, but shall suffer points penalties when judged in Concours, at the discretion of the Chief Judge.

Age and Authenticity - Only Rolls-Royce motor cars built prior to 1940 are eligible for Award. The trophy shall be awarded at the discretion of the Chief Judge, provided that only the age and authenticity of the chassis shall be considered.

The Best Restoration of the Year

Awarded to the 'Best Restoration of the Year' being either a Rolls-Royce or a Bentley motor car, subject to the following:

- a) Any eligible motor car.
- b) The motor car is at least 15 years old.
- c) The restoration was substantially completed in the twelve months immediately preceding the NSW Branch Rally at which it is entered for judging.
- d) The motor car has not previously been entered for the restoration award. Unless the motor car has subsequently been restored to such a significant degree that in the opinion of the Chief Judge, the motor car was eligible for entry.
- e) That the motor car is the subject of the restoration regardless of during whose ownership the restoration was carried out.
- f) To be classified as a 'Restoration' a motor car must be generally in excellent condition and have undergone, within the period specified, major or complete dismantling and extensive or complete overhaul and return to original condition, or as close as possible to original appearance, specification, material specification and finish in at least FOUR (4) of the following SIX (6) major component groups:

1. Chassis and suspension
2. Engine
3. Gearbox and rear axle

4. External panels and paintwork
5. Internal upholstery and woodwork
6. External trimming and plating

Owner Eligibility

The owner of a motor car entered for judging must be a financial member of the RROCA Rolls-Royce & Bentley Car Club NSW at the time of submitting the entry. No motor car will be accepted for entry into the NSW Club Concours unless this entry form has been completed and the Owner's Declaration signed.

Touring Class

This class is for people who use their eligible cars on a regular basis and who have not received a class (or higher) award for that car in a previous NSW Club Concours or previously won the Touring Class.
